- ✓ *When and where was the source produced?*
- ✓ *What contemporaneous events might have affected the author's viewpoints and/or message?*
- ✓ *How does the context affect the reliability?*

AUDIENCE

- ✓ *Who was the source created for?*
- ✓ *How might the audience have affected the content of the source?*
- ✓ *How might the audience have affected the reliability of the source?*

Step 1: Read the Source info first – write all notes in the margins

Step 2: Skim the document, taking careful notes on the beginning and end

Step 3: Critical Analysis (HAPP-Y)

Step 4: Organize the docs for essay usage

PURPOSE

- ✓ *Why did the author create the source?*
- ✓ *Why was the document created at this time?*
- ✓ *Why has it survived to the present?*
- ✓ *How does their purpose affect the reliability or usefulness?*

The Author's

POINT OF VIEW

- ✓ *What was the author's point of view?*
- ✓ *Does the author undermine the explicit purpose of the source?*
- ✓ *How can we tell, if at all, what other beliefs the author might hold?*
