SAMPLE CLAIM ORGANIZED FROM CLASS INPUT

While **both European and Asian empires saw an increasing desire for expansion in** the Early Modern period that **resulted in the interaction of culturally different people around the world**, European expansion in the Americas represented something wholly new in human history. **The creation of an interacting Atlantic world had a more significant impact** on the people that European empires incorporated than did Asian empires, and they had a far wider impact on the world as a whole.
