


What is Progressivism?

- Variety of <u>democratic</u> <u>responses to the</u> <u>economic, social, and</u> <u>political problems</u> rapid industrialization introduced to the United States at the turn of the century (late 1800s and early 1900s)
- Started with social reform efforts on local level and grew to a larger nationwide political movement



What is Progressivism?

- <u>WHO</u> are the Progressives?
 - Many middle-class educated professionals
 - Reformers, activists, and journalist
 - Grass-roots and State/Federal government

• <u>WHAT</u> is Progressivism?

- Collective efforts and ideas of reformers
- Believed that a more effective government could be part of solution
- Use expertise and modern efficiency to better manage society





What is Progressivism?

- <u>WHY</u> did the Progressive movement start?
 - Response to rapid industrialization and its many effects on American society
 - More educated and informed society had time, energy, and knowledge to reform
 - Many Americans felt the negative consequences of industrialization

• **GOALS** of Progressive Reform

- Attempt to improve economic instability and stratification, political corruption and power struggles, and social inequalities and concerns
- Use government intervention to improve lives of Americans
