General Causes...

- Enlightenment thought
- Resistance of colonized peoples to imperial centers

The late 18th and early 19th centuries marked the beginning of an intense period of revolution and rebellion against existing governments.

General Effects...

- Formation of new states and nations
- Stimulated the development of new ideologies
- Inspired more revolutionary and anti-imperialist tendencies
